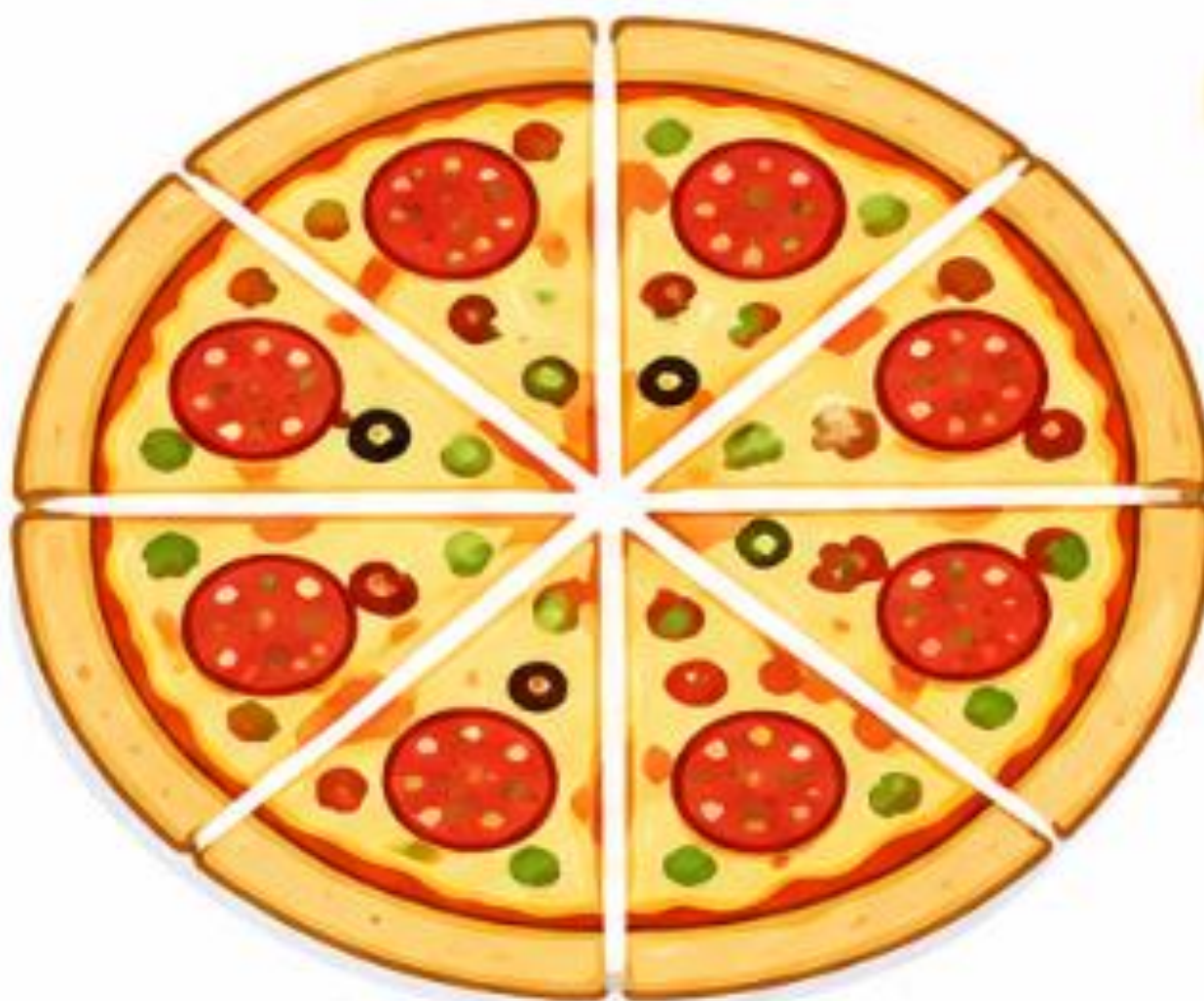
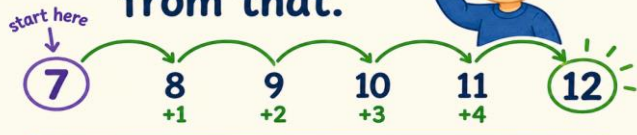




RULE For adding numbers find the largest and count on from that.



The number you land on is the answer.

Rule! To add two digit numbers: use the place value method

- 1** Add the ones

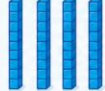
$$\begin{array}{|c|c|} \hline 2 & 4 \\ \hline \end{array} + \begin{array}{|c|c|} \hline 1 & 3 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

$$\downarrow \qquad \downarrow$$
Add the ones = $\begin{array}{|c|} \hline 7 \\ \hline \end{array}$
- 2** Add the tens

$$\downarrow \qquad \downarrow$$
Add the 10s = $\begin{array}{|c|} \hline 20 \\ \hline \end{array} + \begin{array}{|c|} \hline 10 \\ \hline \end{array} = \begin{array}{|c|} \hline 30 \\ \hline \end{array}$
- 3** Add both numbers together
Add both numbers together = $\begin{array}{|c|} \hline 37 \\ \hline \end{array}$

Rule! To partition a number break it down into its place value parts.

Example:
753
 can be partitioned as:

Hundreds	Tens	Ones
		
700	50	3

$$753 = 700 + 50 + 3$$
